

WINTER REMINDERS

Odd/Even Parking: Nov. 1 - March 31

Municipal Code Chapter 10.12.020

“Odd-even parking” means vehicles will be parked on the odd side of a street designated by property addresses on odd days of the month and on the even side of a street on even days of the month.

Between 1 a.m. and 6 a.m., residents and visitors must:

- Park on the **odd-numbered** side of the street on odd dates.
- Park on the **even-numbered** side of the street on even dates.

Failure to follow these parking regulations may result in a ticket and/or tow.

Sidewalk Shoveling

Municipal Code Chapter 12.04.030

City of River Falls residents (owners and occupants) are responsible for removing snow and ice from sidewalks adjacent to their property within 24 hours of each snowfall. If snow/ice is not removed from adjacent sidewalks within 24 hours, residents will receive a door tag warning and citation if not cleared.

The fee for that removal will be billed to the property owner according to the City's current fee schedule, found here: www.rfcity.org/fees. A citation and/or special property tax assessment may be made if payment is not received.
