# Registration Information

## Registration Dates

Online registration opens Monday, March 9, 2026 at 9 a.m. In-person assistance begins on Wednesday, March 11. Some activities fill up fast and you can wait list; others have a deadline.

## Registration Methods

- REGISTER ONLINE at [riverfalls.activityreg.com](http://riverfalls.activityreg.com)
- Mail the registration form to City Hall with your payment (check availability online first)
- Drop off the registration form at City Hall with your payment (check availability online first)
- Stop by City Hall during business hours beginning Wednesday, March 11



## Residency

A RESIDENT is any person who lives or owns property within the corporate city limits of River Falls and receives a property tax bill from the City. (Not to be confused with a School District Resident.) A NON-RESIDENT is anyone who lives outside the City Limits, for example in the Town of River Falls, Troy, Clifton, Kinnickinnic, or in other cities. Only City residents pay property taxes towards City parks and recreation programming. The non-resident surcharge is \$10- \$15 per activity.

## Payment Methods

We accept Visa, Mastercard, Discover, cash, check, or money order. Payment is due at the time of registration.

## Gift Certificates

River Falls Parks & Rec gift certificates can be used toward any recreation program that is instructed by City of River Falls staff. Gift Certificates balances are non-transferable, non-refundable, and not redeemable for cash or credit on account. Lost or stolen certificates will not be replaced. Can only be redeemed in person at City Hall at the time of registration. Gift Certificates purchased in 2026 will expire on December 31st of 2026.



## Financial Assistance

If you live inside City limits and there is a financial hardship that would prevent your child from participating, please fill out the Scholarship Request Form, which can be found on the City website, picked up at City Hall, or you can contact the Recreation office at 715-425-0924 to have it mailed it to you. Please note we can only offer scholarships for activities led by City summer recreation staff.



## Donations/Sponsorships

We always welcome inquiries from individuals, businesses or organizations that are interested in donating to Parks & Rec. Options include a donation to our recreation scholarship fund, a baseball team sponsorship, a special event, or by sponsoring a park bench, tree, dog park or playground equipment donation. ## Waitlist

Once a class/camp is full, please join the waitlist - it's free! This allows us to gauge interest in an activity. You will receive an email invitation to join if someone cancels or if another session is added.

## One Household Only

To keep the registration process fair to all and prevent mix-ups, you may only register for members of your immediate household. Only parents/grandparents/legal guardians may register youth participants.

## Read Your Receipt

Verify that you are enrolled in the correct class/session. Contact Parks & Rec if you need to switch.

## Deadlines and Waitlists

**DEADLINE**

We want to be prepared for your child! In order for us to have adequate staffing and supplies, register *before* the deadline, or *at least* three business days before a program begins. You may NOT register or pay at program site. If a class is full, we encourage you to utilize the wait list, and you will receive an email invitation to register or decline if an opening becomes available.

## Cancellations and Refunds

**CANCELLED**

Cancellations must be made at least three business days before a class begins. There is a \$10 cancellation fee per activity. You may cancel *most* activities online if it is at least two weeks before the activity begins. If it is closer than that, contact the Parks & Rec office to cancel. If your cancellation causes the program number to fall below the required minimum, your refund will be contingent upon the vacancy being filled. Even though there is no refund for a last-minute cancellation, notice is appreciated. No refunds will be given after the program begins. Please note we are only able to return funds to your card up to six months after the purchase date; after that time a check will be issued, which takes two or three weeks. Credit on your Parks & Rec account will expire after one year.

**Program cancellation:** Parks & Rec will refund your entire program fee if a program is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment or staffing reasons.

**Weather cancellations:** Cancellations before 4:30 p.m. will be made via Facebook and through emails to participants. Cancellations after 4:30 p.m. will be made at the program site by the instructor/coach. We will make every effort to give cancellation notice as far in advance as possible. The Department recognizes that severe weather situations vary, therefore parents are encouraged to use their own discretion when deciding whether to send children to programs. If RF schools close early and the program is held at a SDRF location, the program will be cancelled. Every effort will be made to make up missed activities, but there is no guarantee that this will be possible.

## Field and Court Reservations

Some fields and courts can be reserved for a fee. If there are no reservations, they are available free on a first come, first served basis. At the time of printing, Glen Park Pickleball Courts, Glen Park Soccer Fields, and Hoffman Park Softball fields may be reserved online at [riverfalls.activityreg.com](http://riverfalls.activityreg.com) beginning the first Monday of March each year at 9 a.m.. To make your reservations online, visit [riverfalls.activityreg.com](http://riverfalls.activityreg.com) and click on "Reserve a Facility."



## Shelters

Glen Park, Hoffman Park, and DeSanctis Park have shelter buildings that can be reserved online at [riverfalls.activityreg.com](http://riverfalls.activityreg.com) beginning at 9 a.m. on the first Monday of each year for the current calendar year. If you need assistance, in-person reservations open the first Wednesday of each year. Learn more about City shelters on the City website's shelter page at [rfcity.org](http://rfcity.org). Photos, prices, amenity lists, and availability calendars are also located on the reservation website.



## Campground

Hoffman Park Campground has 15 overnight camping spots with electric hook-up, and five tent spots. Bathrooms, shower, water to fill tanks, and dump station are available. The campground is open from April 15 until October 15. The fee is \$30 per night for an electric site or \$15 per night for a non-electric tent site. Campers are required to make a reservation and pay online at [riverfalls.activityreg.com](http://riverfalls.activityreg.com) before setting up. Maps, photos, and rules can be found on the City website's camping page: [rfcity.org](http://rfcity.org). For a non-camper, the dump station fee is \$5 payable by cash or check at the dump site.



## Dog Park

The City of River Falls is excited to offer a place where dogs can socialize off-leash and where owners can meet new people in the community who share a common interest. The 16-acre dog park located at W10225 CTH FF includes a parking lot for 20 vehicles, fenced areas for both large and small dogs, picnic tables, benches, dog waste stations, and a portable restroom. Water is not available at the site; dog owners are encouraged to bring their own water. Hours are daily from dawn to dusk. More information and rules can be found on the City website's dog park page at: [rfcity.org](http://rfcity.org). Dog park pass is required.

# Glen Park Splash Pad

The Glen Park Splash Pad is free and open to the public 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. approximately Memorial Day through at least Labor Day, always weather permitting. Exit at the first sign of lightning or thunder. Watch for updates on the River Falls Parks and Recreation Facebook page. Visitors must adhere to all splash pad rules, which includes no food or beverage inside the fence. Maximum capacity 133 persons.

## Splash Pad Rules

- Use at your own risk.
- Children must be supervised at all times.
- Do not enter if you have a communicable disease or open cut.
- Do not bring in food, drink, gum, tobacco, or vaping products.
- Shower before entering and after toilet use.
- Do not run or engage in rough play.
- Do not drink the treated water.
- No animals except service animals.
- Diaper changing on the deck is prohibited.
- Non-toilet trained children must wear swim diapers.
- Glass and shatterable items are prohibited.
- No hanging, swinging, climbing, or pulling on equipment.
- No profanity or inappropriate behavior.
- No soap, shampoos, or other outside materials.
- No skateboards, bikes, scooters, or other objects allowed.
- Exit at the first sign or lightning or thunder.
- The City may implement and enforce rules that are more stringent or supplement those listed here.

**Cancellations:** If you cancel at least one week (7 days) in advance you will receive a refund minus a \$10 fee. If you cancel within one week (7 days) of your reservation or no-show, you will forfeit your entire fee. If a cancellation is required due to weather, you will receive a refund minus \$10 fee. All guests must follow pool rules and lifeguard instructions.
