Dear Mr. Westhuis:

This letter is in response to your request dated March 7, 2019, to add Schedule NSM-1, Non-Standard Meter Service for the Water Utility. ([PSC REF#: 360924](#), [PSC REF#: 360925](#).) This schedule will coordinate with Schedule NSM-1 of the Electric Utility.

Effective March 27, 2019, the River Falls Municipal Utilities (Utility) will implement Schedule NSM-1 at a rate of \$22.31 per month.

A copy of the new schedule is attached for your reference. The new tariff sheet has been filed at the Commission under Amendment 32.

Please note that the Water Utility shall make these tariff changes available to the public at locations where customer payments are accepted, on the Utility's website, or in a form and place that is otherwise readily accessible to the public, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 196.19. If a copy of the new tariff is not made available to the public by one day before the effective date, the new tariff provisions shall take effect one day after the date it is made available to the public.

Please update the Utility's current tariff by inserting printed copies of the new tariff sheet into the current tariff books. The Utility's current rates and rules must be available for public inspection and review at all of the Utility's bill payment stations and at area libraries, pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § 185.22.

This filing is made with the understanding that it does not result in an unauthorized rate increase or service restriction. Additionally, as required by Wis. Stat. § 196.60, the provisions of the filing shall be applied in a non-discriminatory manner.

Non-Standard Meter Service

The utility shall assess a charge of \$22.31 per month to a customer who is provided service under Schedule Mg-1 and who requests a non-standard meter. The utility may only charge a customer one NSM charge for customers with both water and electric services.

If a customer establishes service at a new location on which a standard meter is installed, and the customer requests non-standard meter service, the utility shall assess the customer a one-time charge, based on actual utility costs, for the installation of a non-standard meter.

If a customer requests initial service at a location where a non-standard meter is installed, the utility may not assess a charge for installing a standard meter. The utility may not charge an existing customer who chooses to convert from a non-standard meter to a standard meter.

Billing: Same as Schedule Mg-1.
